
Apply- School Volunteer




Choose on of the four options that best fits applicant: Parent, Community member, District Special Projects, Contractors




Use the scroll bar to locate the school you would like and click it, then click next




Select Apply or add another site




Once your registration is reviewed you will receive a follow up email with information for logging into your personal dashboard. Please read the welcome letter and follow the instructions.

At this point you will need to go to 640 N. San Joaquin street to be fingerprinted. Your prints will be ran through the Department of Justice and the FBI for any <u>criminal</u> activity. You will also be checked in the Sex Offender data base.



Next Step:

Contact the school Be A Mentor Coordinator where you wish to volunteer to confirm you badge is ready for pick up. Your requirements must all be green. You will not be approved for volunteering if you have committed crimes that coincide with ED Code 44011 or 44010.

Where do I get fingerprinted?

Location: 640 N San Joaquin St. Stockton, CA 95202

Hours: 8:00 am - 4:00 pm

We are closed from 12:00 pm – 1:00 pm for lunch. Last fingerprints are taken at 11:30 am and 3:30 pm

There is no appointment necessary, we operate on a walk-in basis!

Volunteers that have been fingerprinted and issued a volunteer badge for a previous school year do not need to be re-fingerprinted so long as no more than 2 years has passed in between volunteering. You can walk in and obtain a new volunteer badge with the current school year on it. The badge will be sent to the school once completed. You will need to fill out a new live scan form and ensure you TB test is current
