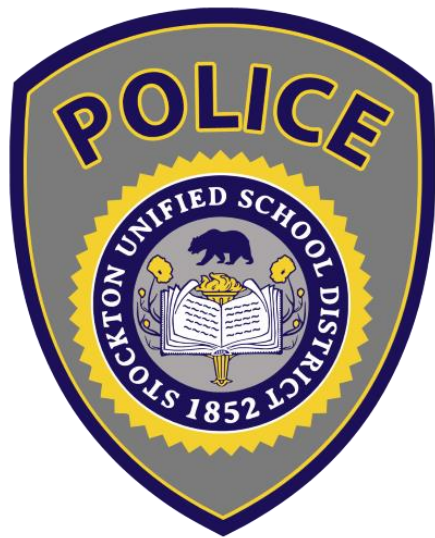

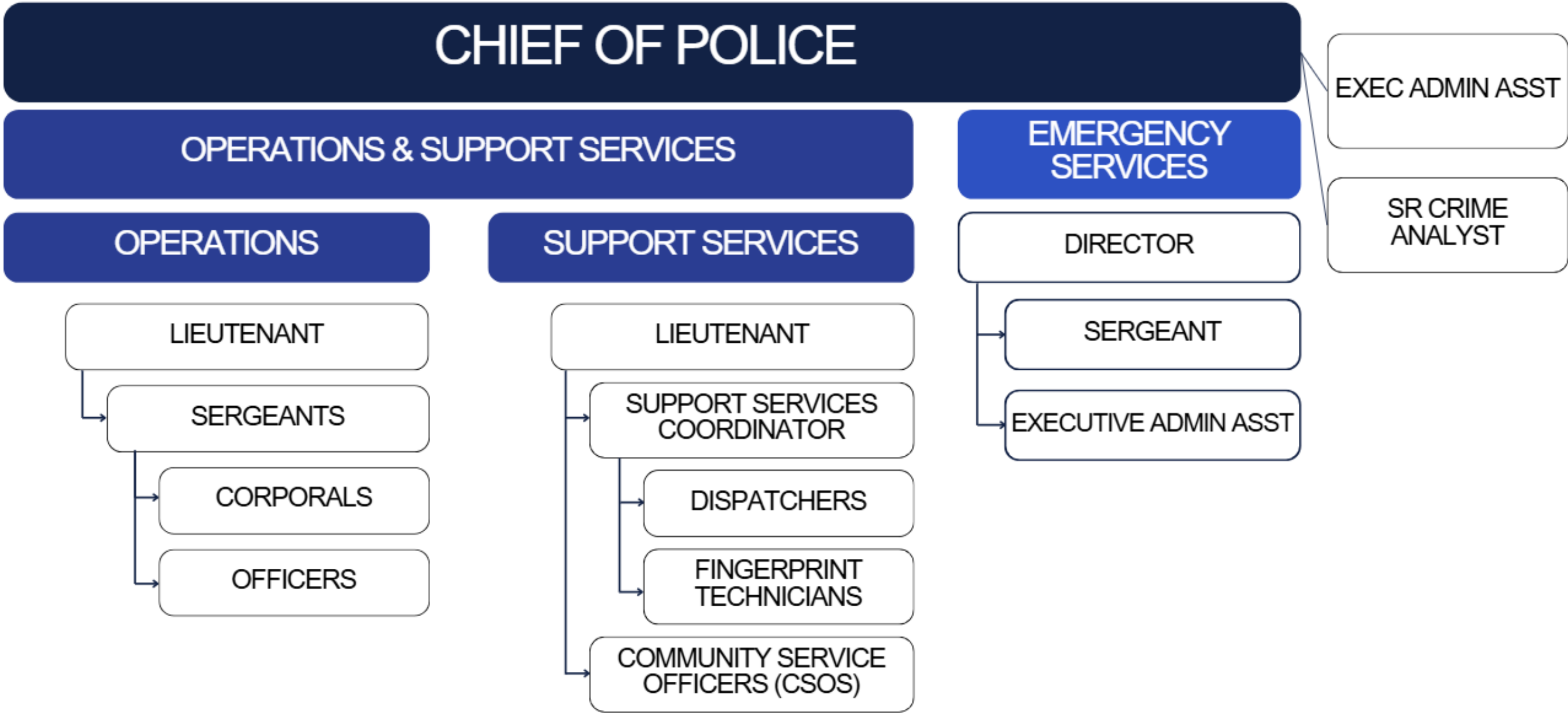

IMAGINING THE POSSIBILITIES: ELEVATING STUDENT, FAMILY AND STAFF VOICES

Panorama is an annual comprehensive national survey that provides a venue for students, families and staff to provide ongoing feedback to the District.

We are listening, and together we can elevate our students' educational experience.

SUSD received **19,517** total survey responses from:

You responded, we listened!

- 70% of families responded favorably, **increasing 4%**, to their feelings on the safety of the school environment
- When specifically asked does your child feel at unsafe at home or at school, families responded 77% favorably, **increasing 6%**
- To build on this, we are continuing the work we started

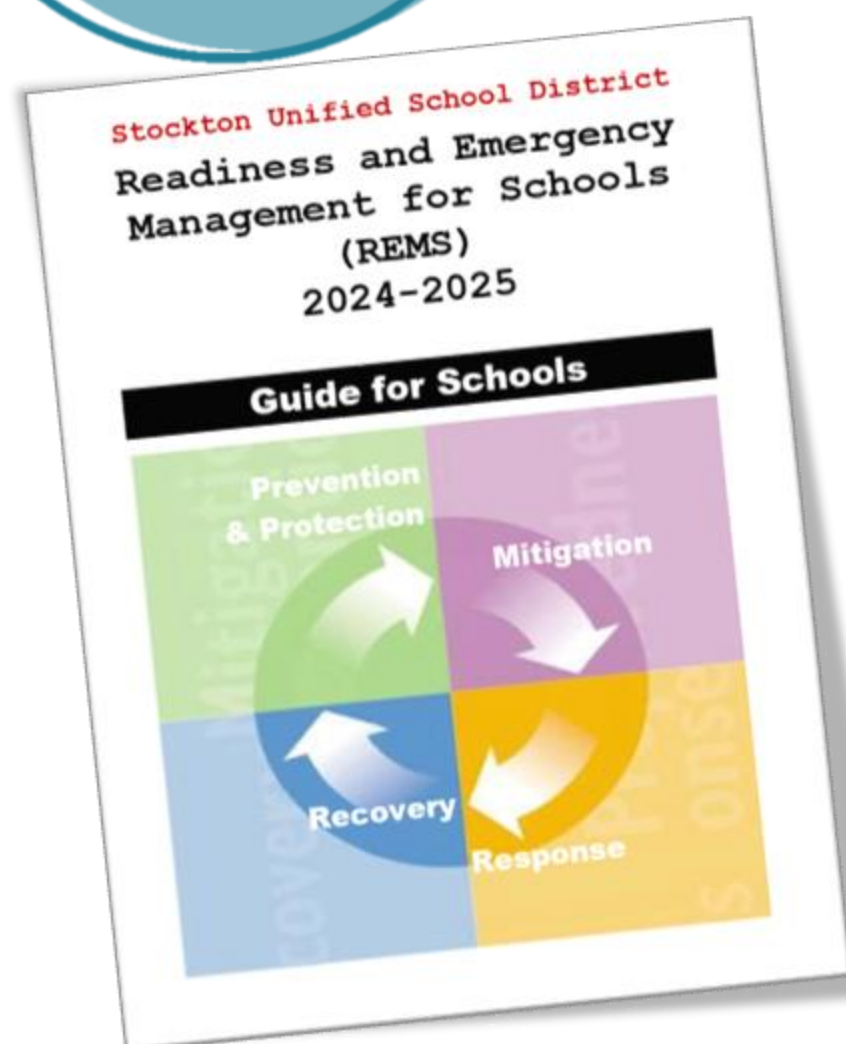

What is the evaluation?

- For the state-required drills (like fire drills), evaluation forms are being submitted **online**

Why does this matter?

- Data will be used to **improve drill performance to keep our staff and students emergency ready**
