 - Certificated in Incident Command and Crime Prevention Through Environmental Design (CPTED)




INTRODUCTIONS: FEEDBACK LOOP



IMAGINING THE POSSIBILTIES: ELEVATING STUDENT, FAMILY AND STAFF VOICES


Panorama is an annual comprehensive national survey that provides a venue for students, families and staff to provide ongoing feedback to the District.


We are listening, and together we can elevate our students' educational experience.



You responded, we listened!

- 70% of families responded favorably, increasing 4%, to their feelings on the safety of the school environment
- When specifically asked does your child feel at unsafe at home or at school, families responded 77% favorably, increasing 6%
- To build on this, we are continuing the work we started





DRILLS: GOING ONLINE






Launched
